TOSC

The Outpatient Surgery Center, more commonly known as TOSC, is a state-of-the-art multi-specialty for profit ambulatory surgery center located on the Self Regional Healthcare campus adjacent to the hospital. This center was developed and is operated as a joint partnership between Self Regional Healthcare System and the surgeons of all specialties. TOSC houses 5 fully equipped operating rooms, all equipped to perform general anesthesia. Most outpatient eye surgery is performed in this center.

We are blessed with a great hospital system and medical staff of 200 physicians representing approximately 40 specialties and subspecialties. Self Regional Healthcare is a major hospital system serving a 7 county area of approximately 210,000 lives.
